Conference Aims

John Owen was an immensely gifted theologian who led the Puritans in the academic arena during the 1600's. Few authors today could match his depth of spiritual and biblical understanding. His work on sin and temptation is as practical and needed today as it was in the 1650's.

Andrew Murray preached to churches all over South Africa during the 1800's. Murray spoke with a sensitivity to the Holy Spirit as few men in our day ever could. In his preaching and writing, there is a constant call to receive from God's Spirit that awakens such holy desires within God's children.

Our aims for this conference are to:

- **encourage** both the depth of Owen's theology and the power of Murray's emphasis on experiencing Christ through the Holy Spirit;
- **help** us see how the cross of Jesus Christ applies to *all* of life – spiritual growth, education, career, family, recreation, emotions, etc.; and,
- **ignite** in us a passion to experience the power of the cross for the glory of God and the joy of His people.

Jim serves as Assistant Professor of Biblical Studies at Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary's Houston campus. He also serves as Preaching Elder at Baptist Church of the Redeemer in Southwest Houston. He is the author of *God's Indwelling Presence: The Holy Spirit in the Old and New Testaments*.
